How does AMCAS work?



Application Submitted

- Applicant completes & submits AMCAS application online
- Applicant pays submission fees (or uses valid Fee Assistance Program benefits)



Application Processed

- Applicant arranges for all required official transcripts to be sent to AMCAS
- AMCAS performs verification of coursework and calculates AMCAS GPAs



Application Delivered

- AMCAS
 distributes
 verified
 application to
 designated med
 schools
- AMCAS delivers letters to designated med schools as they are received



2024-2025 Application Dates

Date	Event
April	2025 AMCAS resources available
May 1	AMCAS application opens
May 28	AMCAS application submission begins
June 28	Initial transmission of application data to medical schools
August 1	Early Decision Program deadline
SeptDec.	Application deadlines

UI CCOM does not have early decision.

May take six-eight weeks for verification.

That's normal-don't panic!



2024-2025 AMCAS Participation

- The 2024-2025 AMCAS processing fee is \$175, which includes one medical school designation.
 - Additional medical school designations are \$46 each
- Be strategic about applying- this is not a wager where more is better!
- Most US medical schools (MD-granting) use AMCAS







An updated list indicating which schools participate in the PREview® professional readiness exam; schools not participating will not receive PREview scores.









UI transcript request form






Withdrawals

Such courses usually appear on the transcript as a "W" or equivalent symbol. No credit hours or AMCAS grade will be assigned for Withdrawals, except in cases where the school includes the Withdrawal failing grade in the GPA as a "F".

A course entry should not be made if the course was dropped within the normal drop/add period and does not appear on the official transcript. If the course was drop/add outside the normal period and does appear on the official transcript, a course entry should be made



Letters of Evaluation

Add	Add Letter of Evaluation/Recommendation						
0	Many medical schools determine whether or not an applicant has met their letter of evaluation/recommendation requirements by the type of letters they receive in support of an application. For example, a medical school may require a committee letter OR three individual letters in support of your application. Please review the AMCAS Applicant Guide for more information about Letters of Evaluation.						
	Please identify the type of letter you wish to enter. If you are uncertain as to the type of letters provided by your school/institution, please ask your pre-health advisor or career center prior to answering this question.						
0	Committee Letter: A committee is a letter authored by a pre-health committee or pre-health advisor and intended to represent your institution's evaluation of you. A committee letter may or may not include additional letters written in support of your application. A Committee Letter is sometimes called a composite letter.						
0	Letter Packet: A packet or set of letters assembled and distributed by your institution, often by the institution's career center.						
0	Individual Letter: An individual letter refers only to a letter authored by, and representing, a single letter writer. If you have already included an individual letter within either a committee letter or letter packet, you do not need to add a separate entry for the individual letter.						
0	Select a meaningful Letter Title, as you may need this title later to identify a letter. For example, if this letter were from the University Of X, with a primary contact of John Doe, and you intend to have this letter sent only to MD/PhD programs, you might create a title of "UX_Doe_MD_PhD".




Letters of Evaluation

- The UI does not provide committee letters of evaluation or letter packets.
- All individual letters of reference
- AMCAS will accept 10 letters
 choose which letters for which school
- UI Carver College of Medicine:
 - Three letters required. Four preferred!
 - No requirement on type


Some questions you may want to consider while drafting this essay are:

In addition, you may wish to include information such as:


- · Special hardships, challenges or obstacles that may have influenced your educational pursuits
- · Commentary on significant fluctuations in your academic record which are not explained elsewhere in your application



³Test scores, like other measurements, are not perfectly precise. The confidence bands around test scores mark the ranges in which the test taker's true scores probably lie. The diamond shapes and shading show that the test taker's true scores are more likely to be their reported scores (in the second column) than the other scores in the confidence bands.


²The percentile ranks of scores are the percentages of test takers who received the same scores or lower scores. The percentile ranks are updated on May 1 every year to reflect the results from the three most recent previous calendar years.

For the four sections, non-overlapping confidence bands show a test taker's likely strengths and weaknesses. Overlapping confidence bands suggest that there are not meaningful differences in performance between sections.


What's a competitive MCAT score?

511 and above	Competitive



Secondary Applications

Additional information requested from each school

- CCOM secondary application portal opens July 10 deadline Dec. 15, 2024 (preferred by Oct. 15)
- Secondary fees vary from \$50-150 per school
 - CCOM \$60
 - --Why Carver College of Medicine?
 - --Describe personal characteristics you've overcome to contribute to a dynamic healthcare system that advocates for all peoples
 - --Describe your healthcare experiences.



Minimum for CCOM secondary

- 500 minimum MCAT
- 123 minimum each MCAT subsection
- 3.00 minimum BCPM and AO GPA

Some schools send secondaries to everyone: Yale, Johns Hopkins, Harvard....

..Be strategic and use the MSAR!



CCOM Interview format

Candidates are interviewed individually by two faculty members for 25 minutes. The day includes a casebased learning session facilitated by M4 students. Both virtual and in person interviews are available.

Carver conducts "closed file" interviews - interviewers are faculty volunteers and want to get to know candidates "off of paper" completely. Do not let this scare you!



CCOM timeline



Earliest application reviews: early to mid July



First interviews: September 9



Secondary app preferred deadline: October 15



Interviews end: Mid January



Final pool decisions: Mid March
